

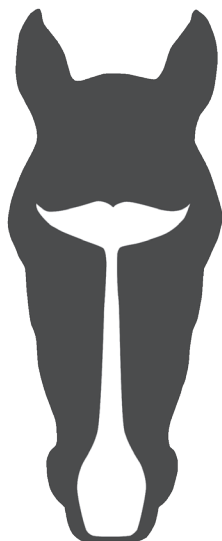

RULES AND INFORMATION

COVID-19 Protocol- Anyone with a fever, cough, shortness of breath or sore throat is not allowed on the site. Maintain social distancing of 6 feet or one horse length at all times. No more than one person at a time will be allowed within 6 feet of ingate/staff. We encourage everyone to wear mask or face covering. We encourage everyone to enter online or mail entry forms to cut down on correspondence with staff. Only one representative per barn will be allowed in the office. It the responsibility of any person entering the site to follow the Covid-19 Guidelines.

1. ENTRY CLOSE DATE: Entries for the Mother's Day Invitational close Wednesday, April 27, 2022

2. ENTRY PROCEDURES: One check per owner. Exhibitors may submit entries with either check or credit card. Exhibitors may also enter online by credit card, at www.horseshowtime.com

1. Exhibitors may choose to pre-pay all fees, or
2. Exhibitors may pay the total of:
 - 1.) A deposit fee of \$50 per horse
 - 2.) All stall and tack room fees
3. If the entry blanks are postmarked on or before the closing date of entries and are fully complete, the \$50 deposit will be credited to the entries due. Late and/or improper entries will forfeit the deposit.

TO BE COMPLETE, ENTRY FORMS MUST INCLUDE:

- 1.) Horse's name and complete descriptions,
 - 2.) All classes or sections entered,
 - 3.) All mandatory signatures,
 - 4.) Organization membership numbers,
 - 5.) Current microchip number.
 4. Trainers and owners may leave a signed open check or credit card authorization for charges during show.
All accounts are to be closed by 5:00 p.m. Sunday, or the close of the show.
 5. All entries postmarked after July 1st will be charged a \$50 late fee.
 6. Exhibitors will receive their prize money within three weeks after the Horse Show.
- 3. CREDIT CARDS:** Exhibitors wishing to pay by credit card will be charged a 3% convenience fee per entry.
- 4. POST ENTRIES & SCRATCHES:** Refunds will be given for scratched classes only if the show office is notified before the class starts.
- 5. SUBSTITUTIONS:** A new horse/pony may be substituted for a scratched horse/pony. Any added or scratched classes will be treated under post entries and scratches.
- 6. CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES AND REFUNDS:** Exhibitors cancelling entries after the closing date forfeit all entry fees, except in the case of disability of a horse, when entries shall be refunded upon presentation of a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian prior to the first class in which the horse is entered.
1. No refunds of entry fees shall be made after the first class in which the horse is entered unless a certificate of disability is presented to the horse show office.
 2. There will be a \$50 office charge.
 3. No stall fees shall be refunded unless requested directly to the show secretary before April 27, 2022
 4. Refunds will be mailed within three weeks after the Horse Show.
- 7. RETURNED CHECKS/CREDIT CARDS:** There will be a penalty of \$75 per check/credit card returned by the bank for any reason. No checks/credit cards will be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, the fees and penalty must be paid before 4:00p.m. the day before the Horse Show starts. No personal checks will be cashed at the Show. Please plan accordingly.

9. MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill to their satisfaction. Notice will be given to exhibitors affected. Management reserves the right to start the first class of any session 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges, or class orders to facilitate time schedule and conditions.

10. TROPHIES, RIBBONS, PRIZE MONEY: Trophy and ribbons will be awarded to six places in regular classes and eight places in Classics and Mini Prix. Prize money for special classes is as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%, unless specified otherwise.

11. HORSE SHOW OFFICE: There will be a \$50 per horse show office fee. Show office hours are as follows:

Thursday: 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

Friday through Sunday: 7:00 a.m. to 1/2 hour after end of show.

12. STABLING: Permanent box stalls with doors on dirt footing provided. Shavings shall be provided for the show for an additional per bag fee. Stalls will be available at noon beginning on Thursday, May 6. Stalls must be vacated no later than 11:00am Monday, May 10. Fee for box is \$225 per stall fee for the week-end. Please indicate arrival and departure date and who you are to be stabled with on the entry blank. Exhibitors do their own stall cleaning. No stall refunds will be given unless requested to the show secretary prior to April 30. Refunds after those dates will only be made if the stall is reissued to another entry.

13. SHAVINGS & MANURE DISPOSAL FEE: Bagged shavings will be available for purchase for \$12 per bag. There will be a \$35 per shavings & manure disposal fee.

14. SCHOOLING AND EXERCISE: Schooling areas will be available for use before and during the show. Schooling in the performance ring will be allowed on Thursday, May 5, 2022 from 12:00pm- 5:00pm. A schooling fee of \$40 will be charged to all entries. Hard hats must be worn while schooling.

15. HELMETS: Helmets must be worn at all times when mounted on the show grounds.

16. TRAILER OR CAMPER HOOK-UPS: Trailer and camper parking is available. Dry camping only. \$100 for the weekend.

17. HAUL-INS: Haul ins will not be allowed.

18. ARENAS & FOOTING: Indoor Jumper Ring is 100' x 200'. The footing is GGT sand. Outdoor Jumper Ring is 250' x 225' with sand footing.

19. VACCINE REQUIREMENTS: ALL horses and ponies attending our show will be required to show proof of vaccine for EHV-1 within the last 6 months during check in.
